



Illustrated with images of 18th-century caricatures held in New College and The British Museum, this is the first full-length biography in over 70 years of George III's mercurial Lord Chancellor—Edward, 1st Baron Thurlow. Thurlow served as one of the primary law officers of the Crown during some of the most tumultuous decades in modern British history. As Solicitor General, Attorney General, and finally Lord Chancellor, he was a key advisor and staunch defender of government policy throughout the American Revolution, during the East India Company's rise as a territorial power in India, and during the early stages of the British reaction to the French Revolution.
