WELCOME to New College Chapel, where worship has been offered since the late fourteenth century. We hope you will find peace and space for reflection in this beautiful building, built to the glory of God and intended to resound with music and words of praise.

This term's music moves from the splendour of Epiphany into more introspective territory with Candlemas and Lent. Our termly Cantata Vespers features one of the relatively small number of cantatas Bach composed while Organist and *Konzertmeister* to the Ducal Court of Weimar; he re-used *Komm, du süße Todesstunde* as Kantor in Leipzig, on the Feast of the Presentation. Since that feast (also known as The Purification of Mary, or traditionally in England as Candlemas) is marked at New College with a festal Evensong, we have extended our celebration of it back to the previous Sunday, enabling a performance of this exquisite cantata alongside music by Schütz and Gabrieli. Term ends with our annual liturgical performance of Bach's *St John Passion*. Music by living composers includes a new *Nunc dimittis* by Caitlin Harrison, and Kim Porter's anthem *The single loving heart*, commissioned by the college last year. New sets of the Preces and Responses by Dónal McCann and Zachary Roberts also feature; composers who, like them, are former or current New College musicians, are identified by the superscript initials *NC*.

The short night office of Compline is sung in 2nd and 5th Weeks. Weekly organ recitals take place on Thursday lunchtimes, and there are chamber music recitals on Monday of 5th and 7th Weeks.

The annual Chorister Open Day takes place on Saturday 6 June from 4.00 pm: please contact choir@new.ox.ac.uk for further information and to book a place.
